

ISP 372

International Baccalaureate (IB) Policy

PURPOSE

Establishes regulation and conditions for awarding college credit based on International Baccalaureate Exam (IB) scores.

SUMMARY

Clackamas Community College awards IB credit to students who have completed an IB exam in a recognized subject area in accordance with the following conditions.

STANDARD

- The College will follow the current statewide guidelines for the awarding of credit. Course equivalency will be determined by the department. (See ISP 372A International Baccalaureate (IB) Credit Table and ISP 372P International Baccalaureate (IB) Procedure).
- 2. IB credit will be noted on the student transcript and may be applied towards course equivalencies, program requirements, and degree completion.
- 3. IB credit may not be applicable to all programs and/or pre-requisites.
