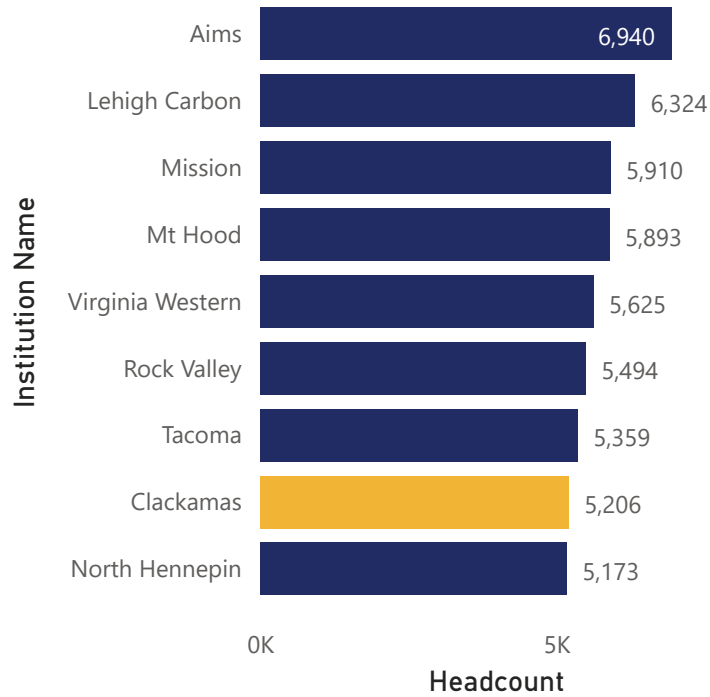

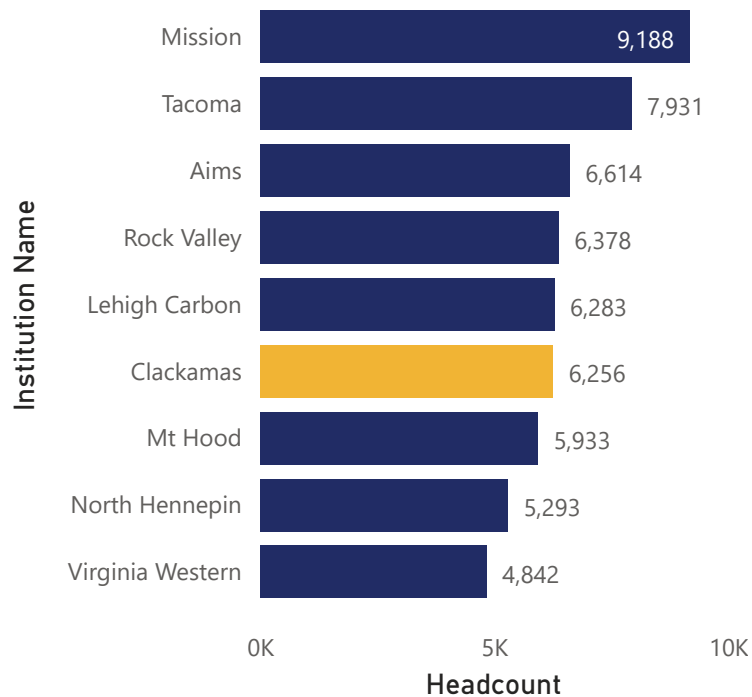

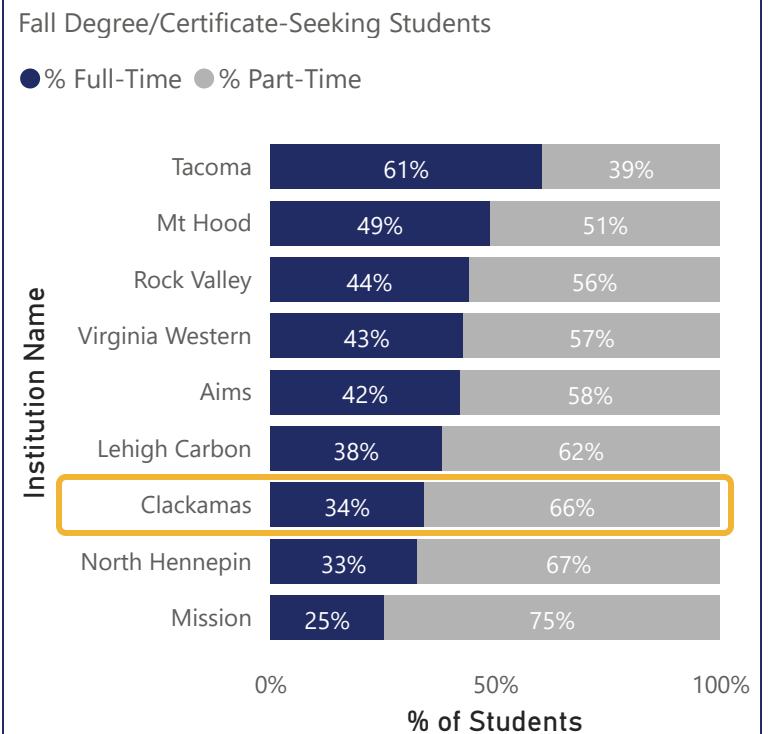

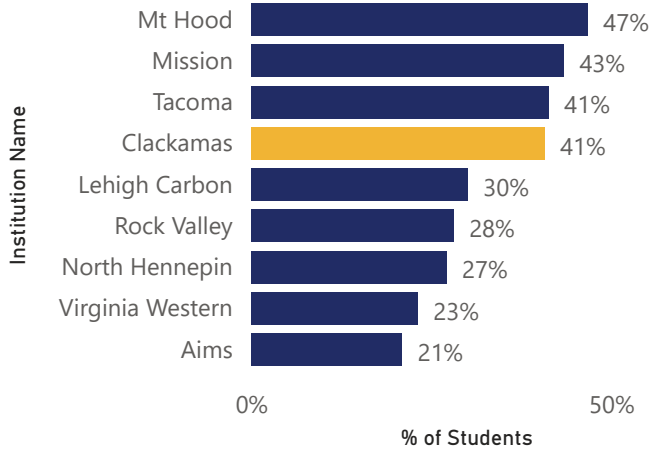
Full-Time and Part-Time Distribution

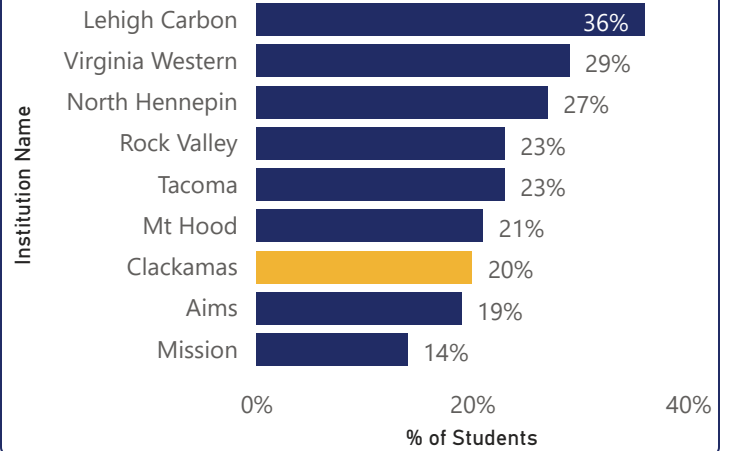

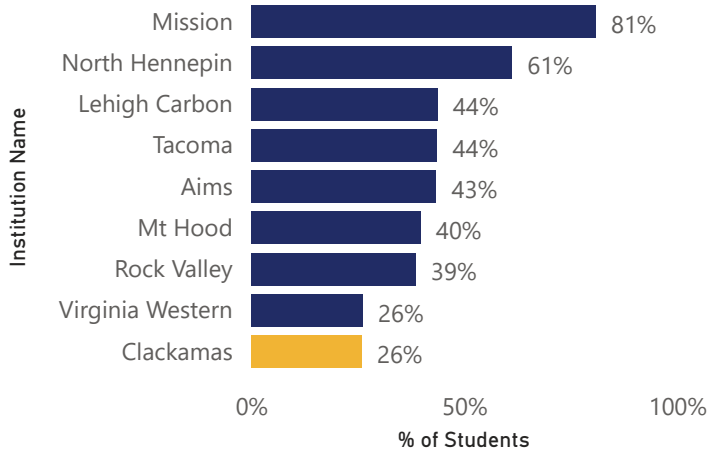
Percent PELL Eligible

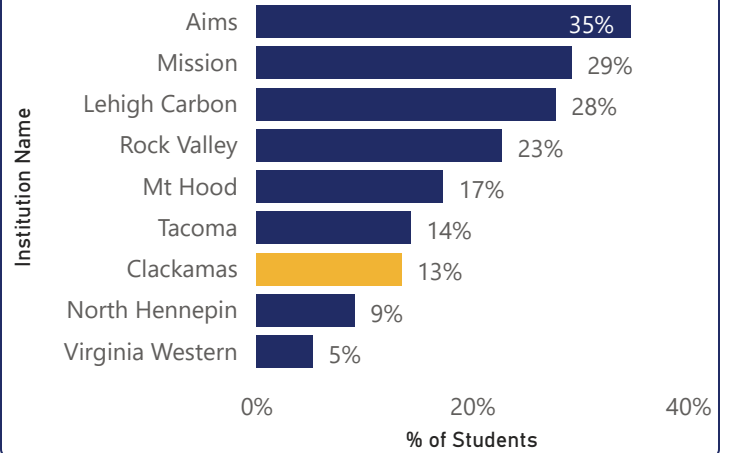
Percent Students of Color

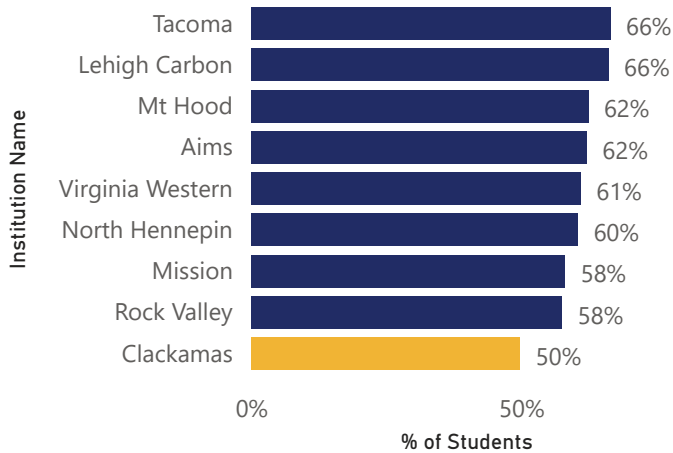
Percent Hispanic

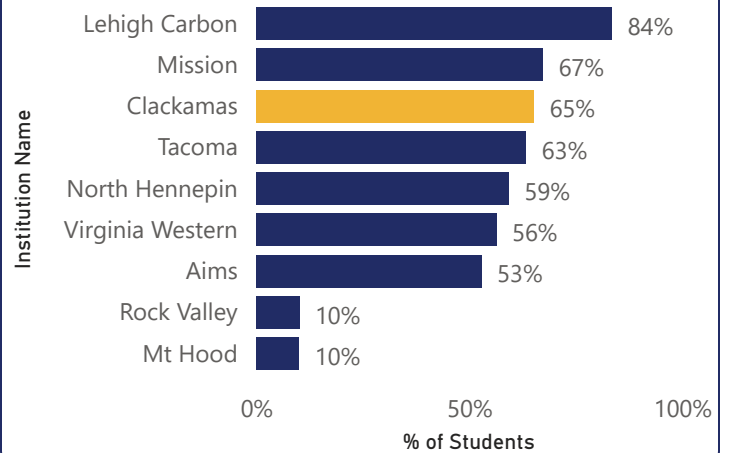
Percent Female

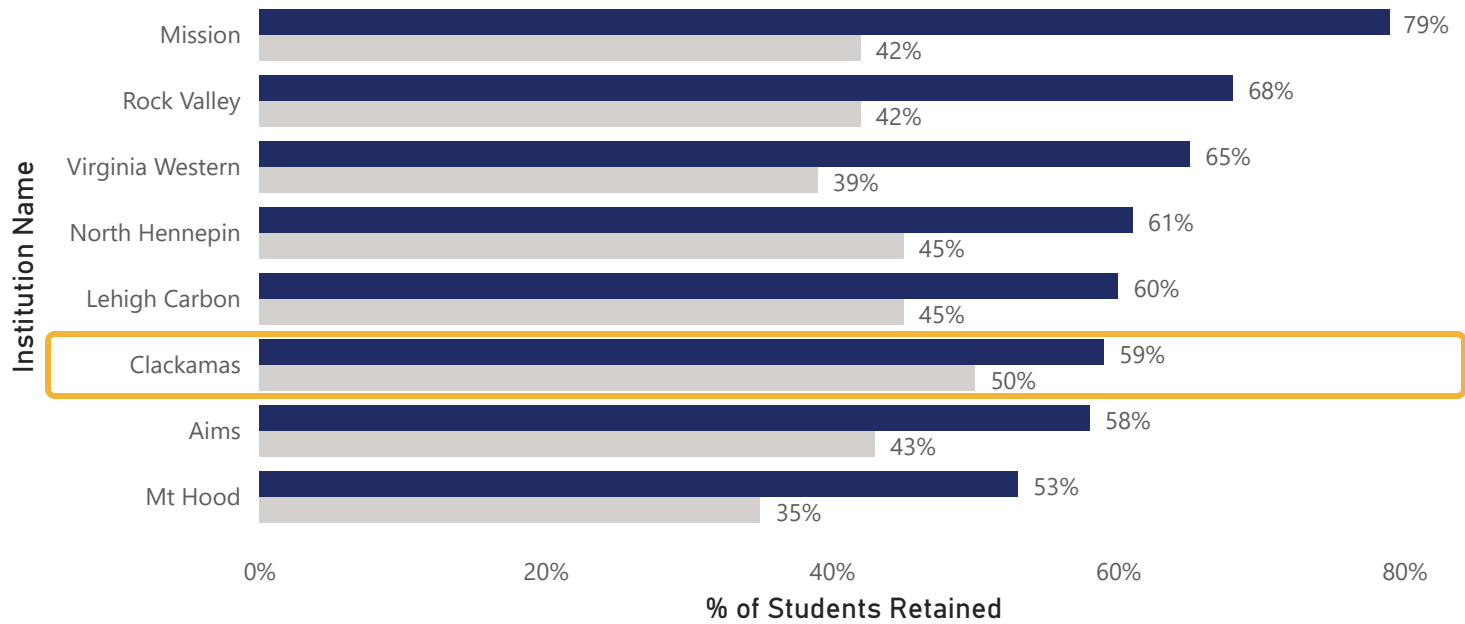

● % of Full-Time Students ● % of Part-Time Students

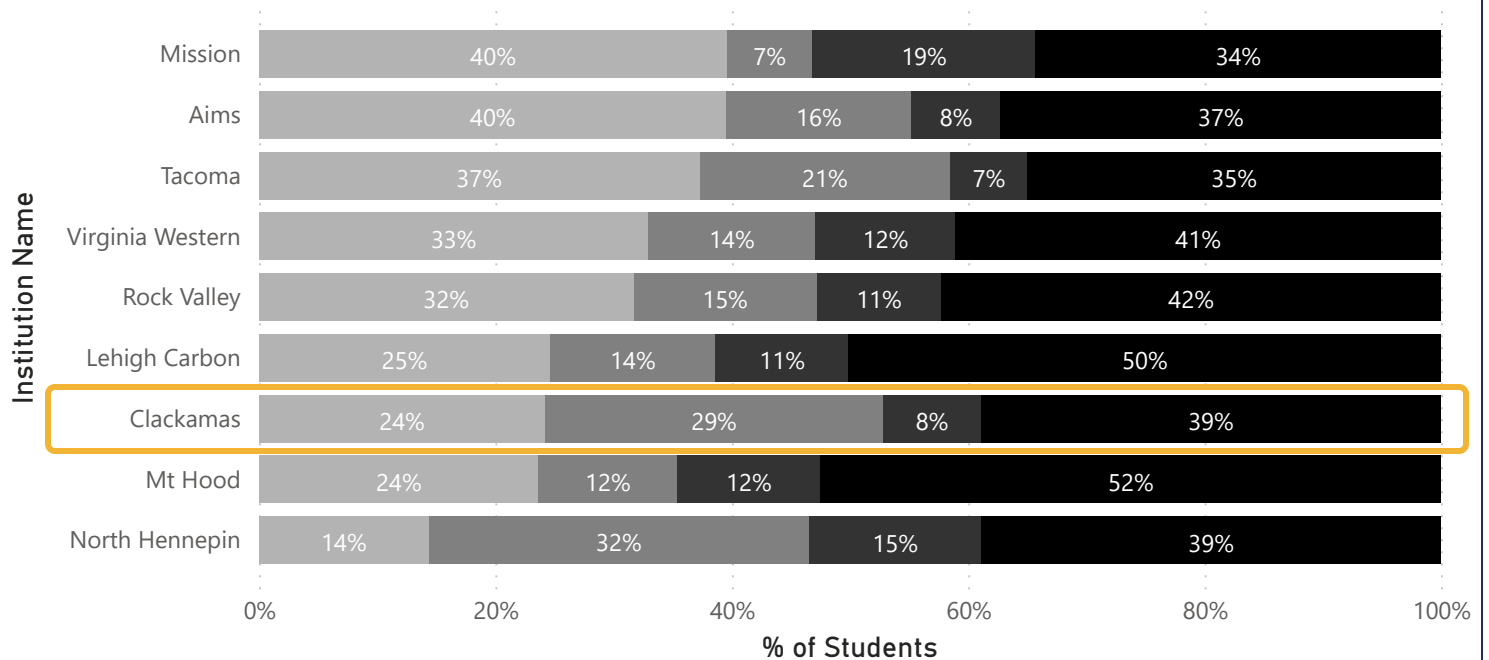

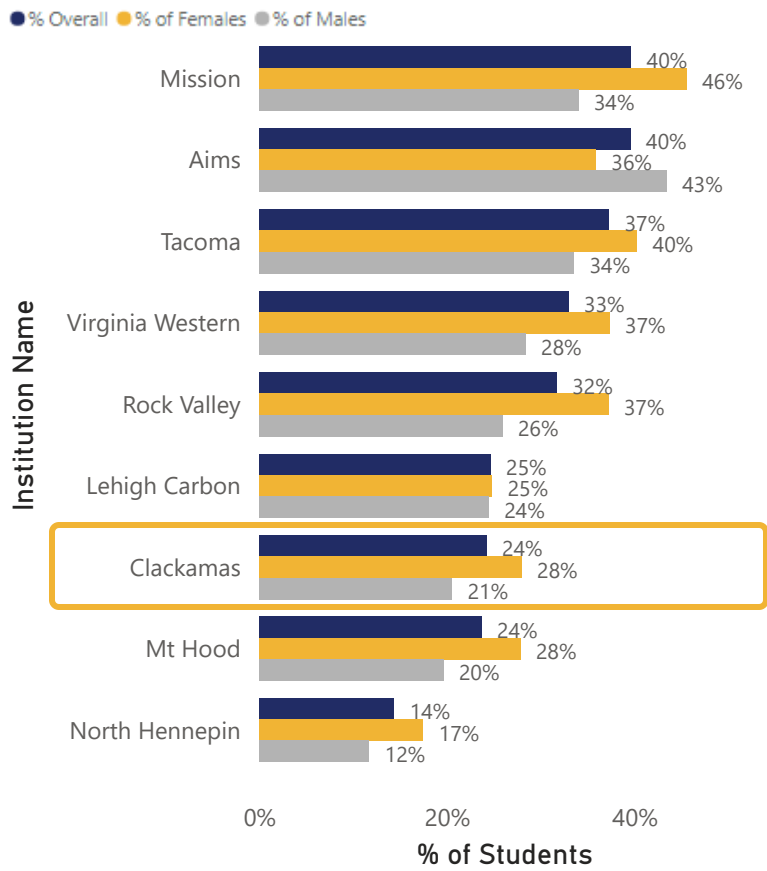

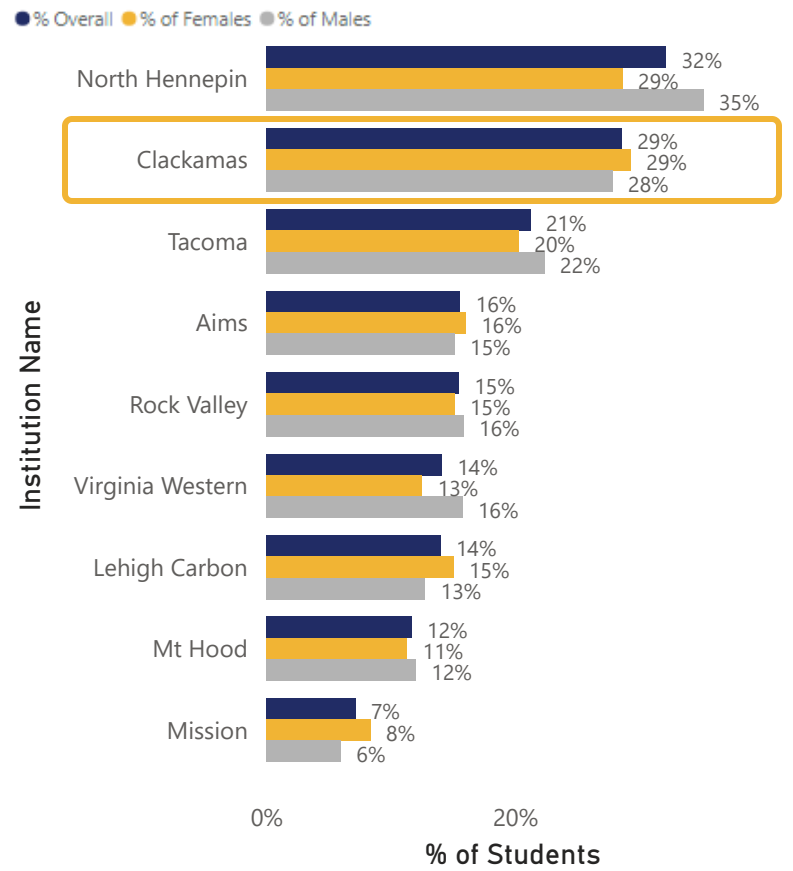


Persistence by Legal Sex

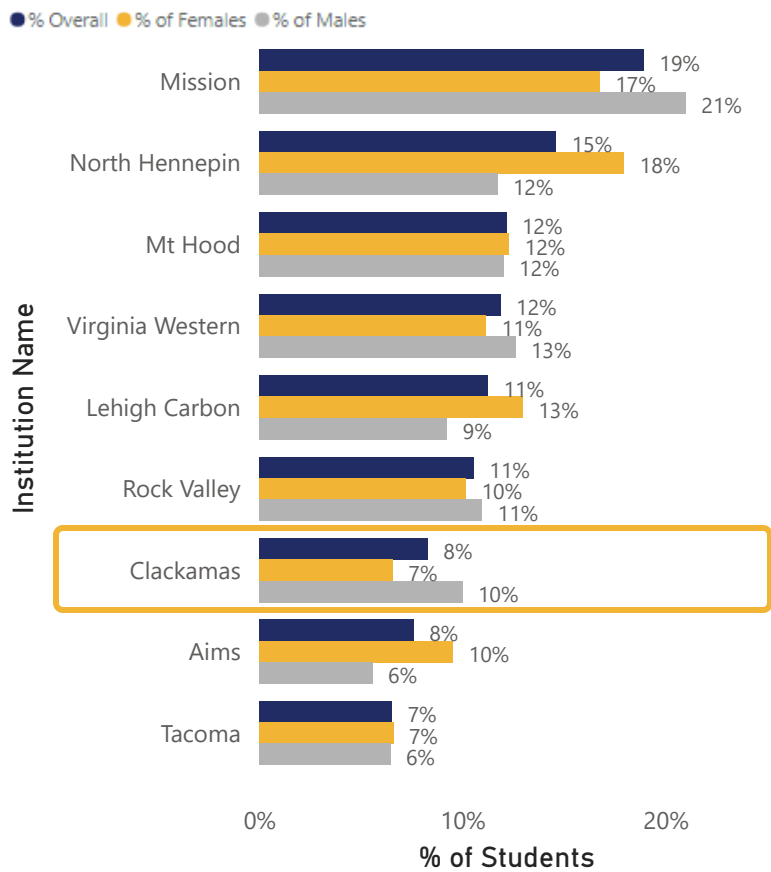

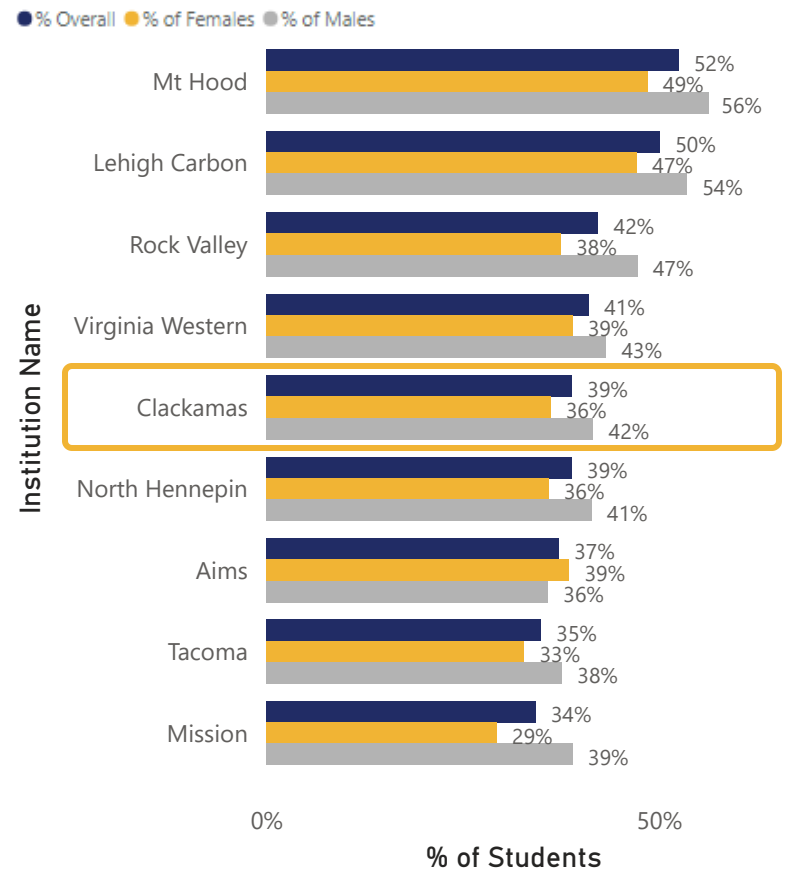

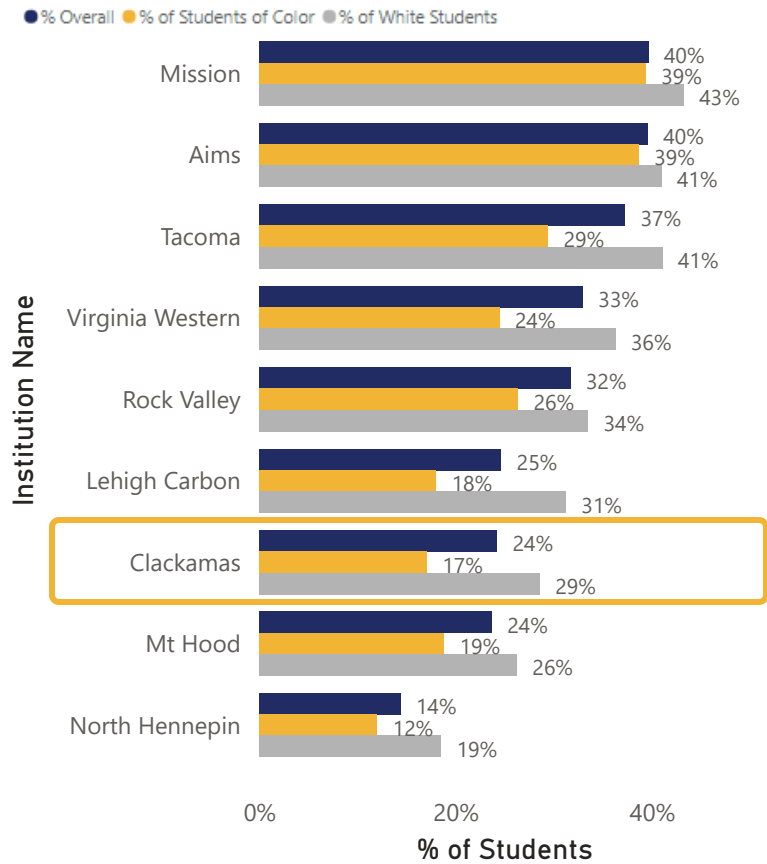

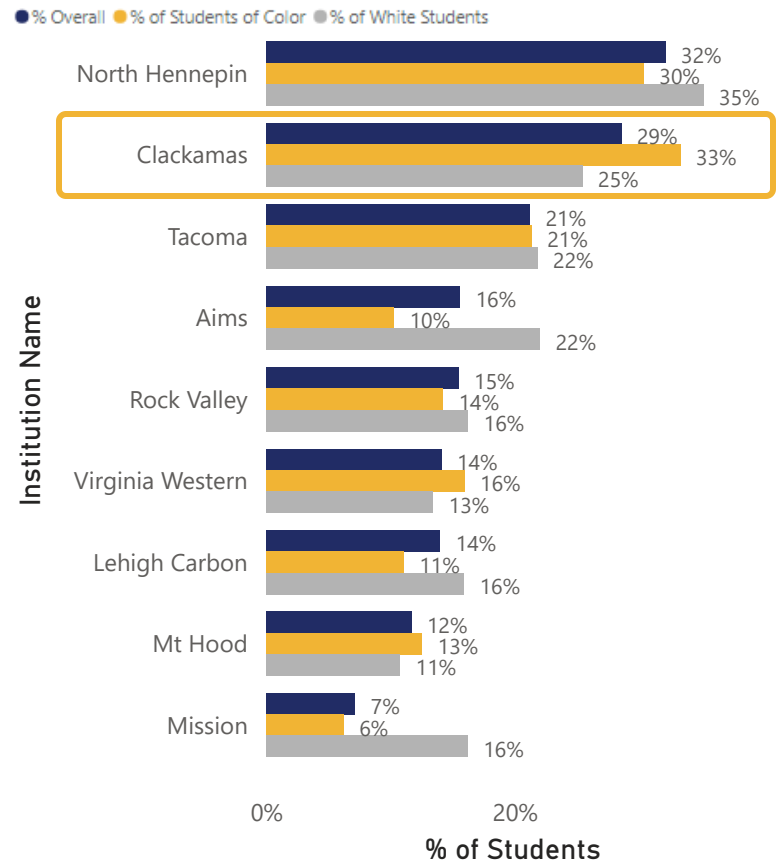


Persistence by Race / Ethnicity

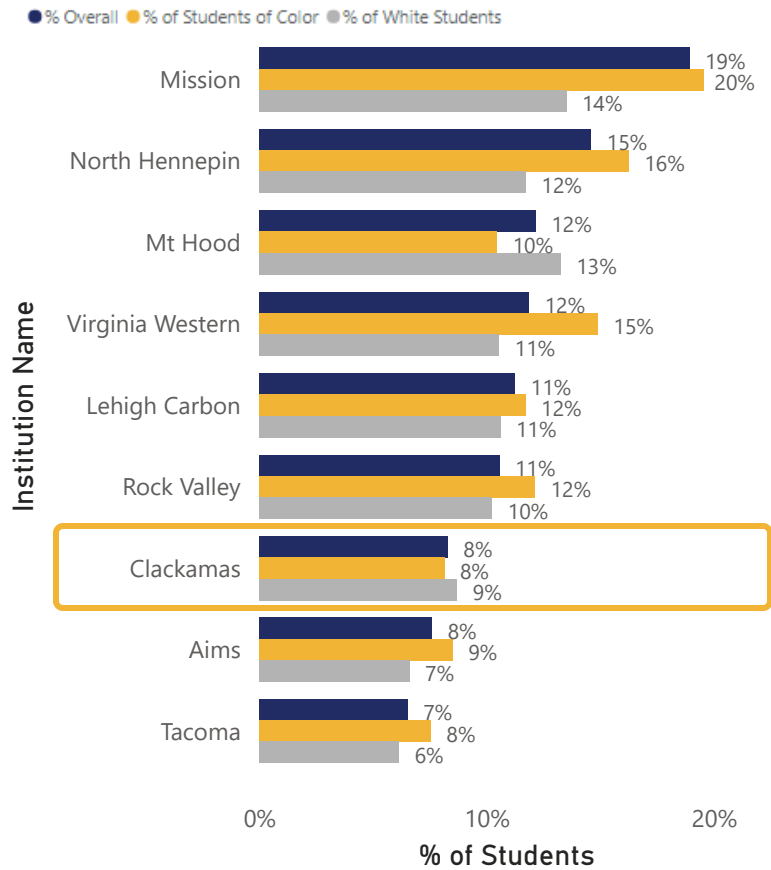

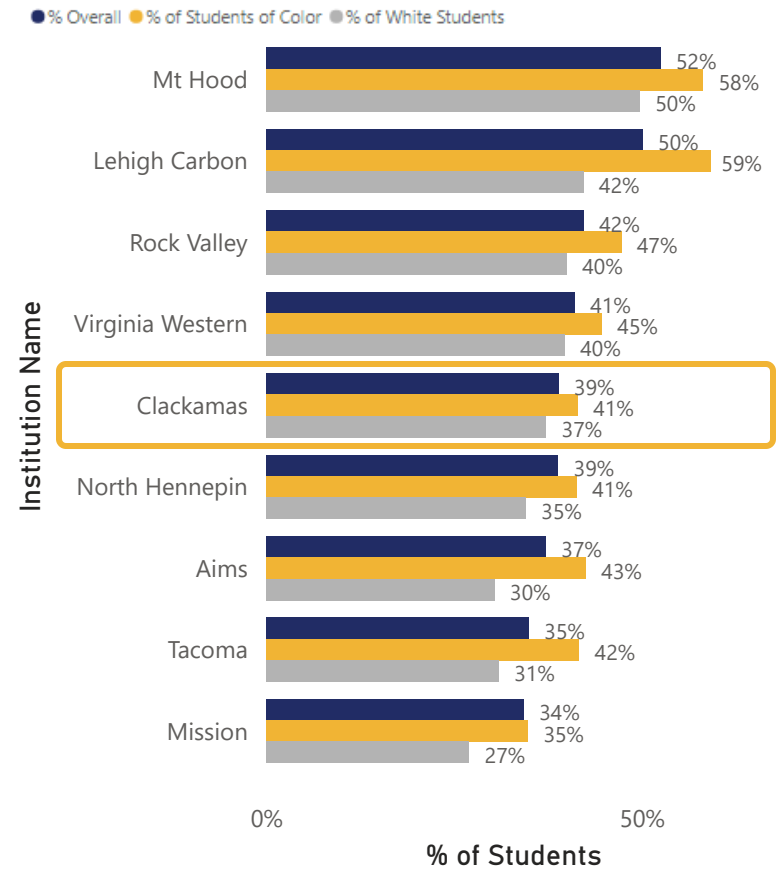

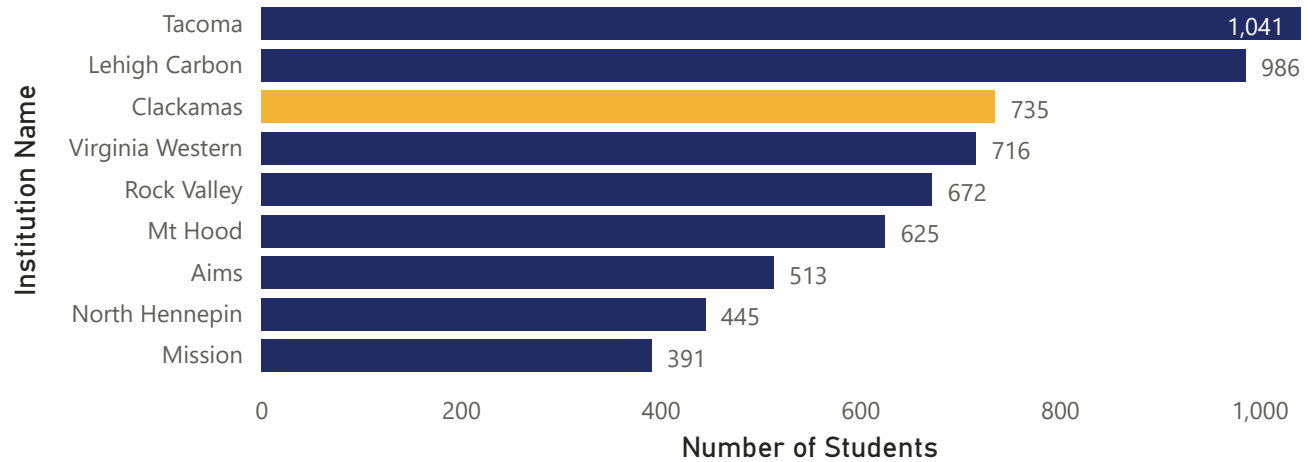

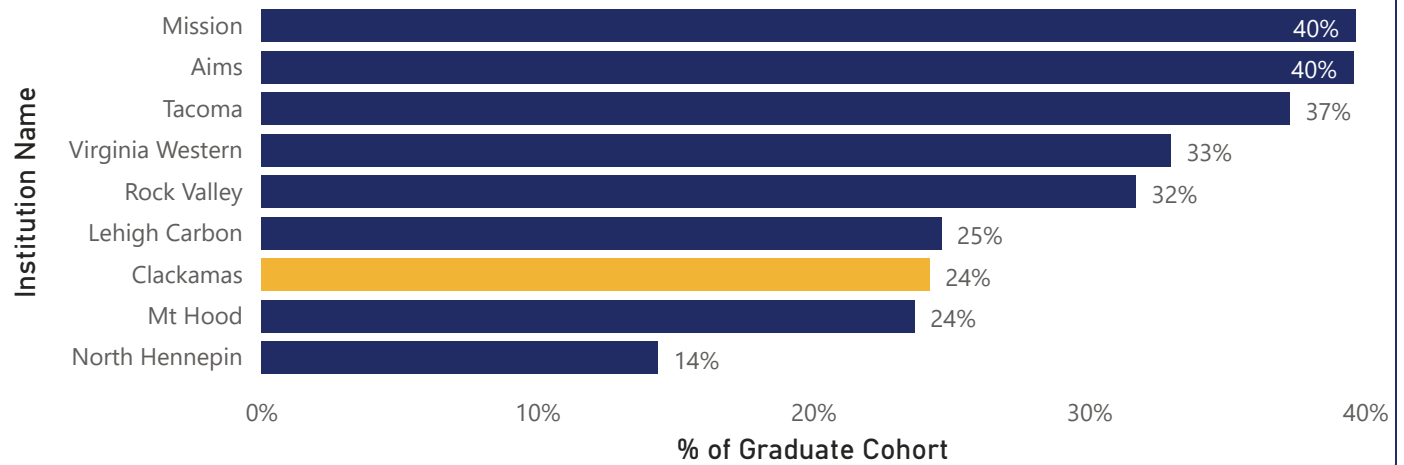

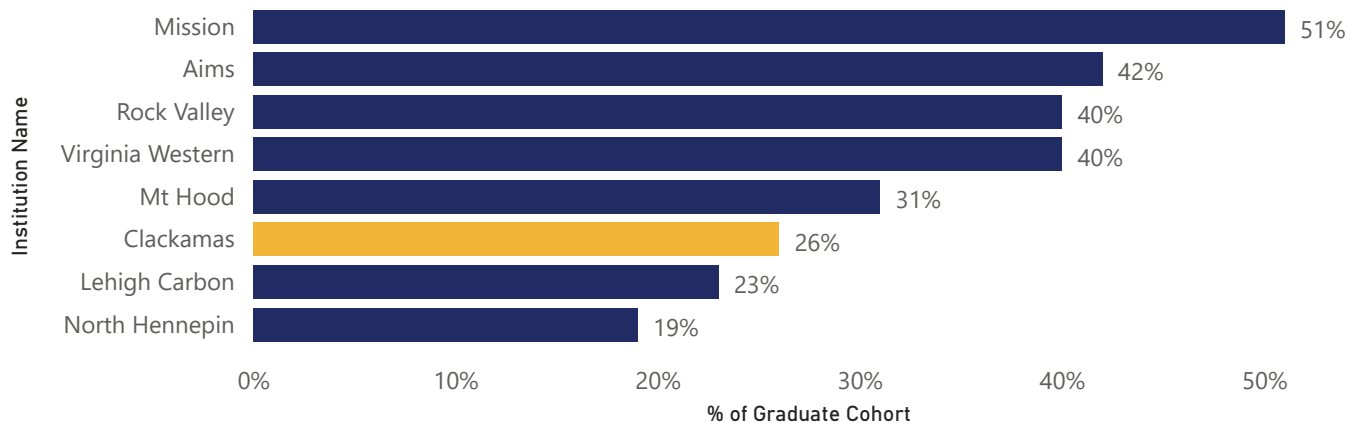
Percent of Graduate Cohort who Completed within 150% of Time

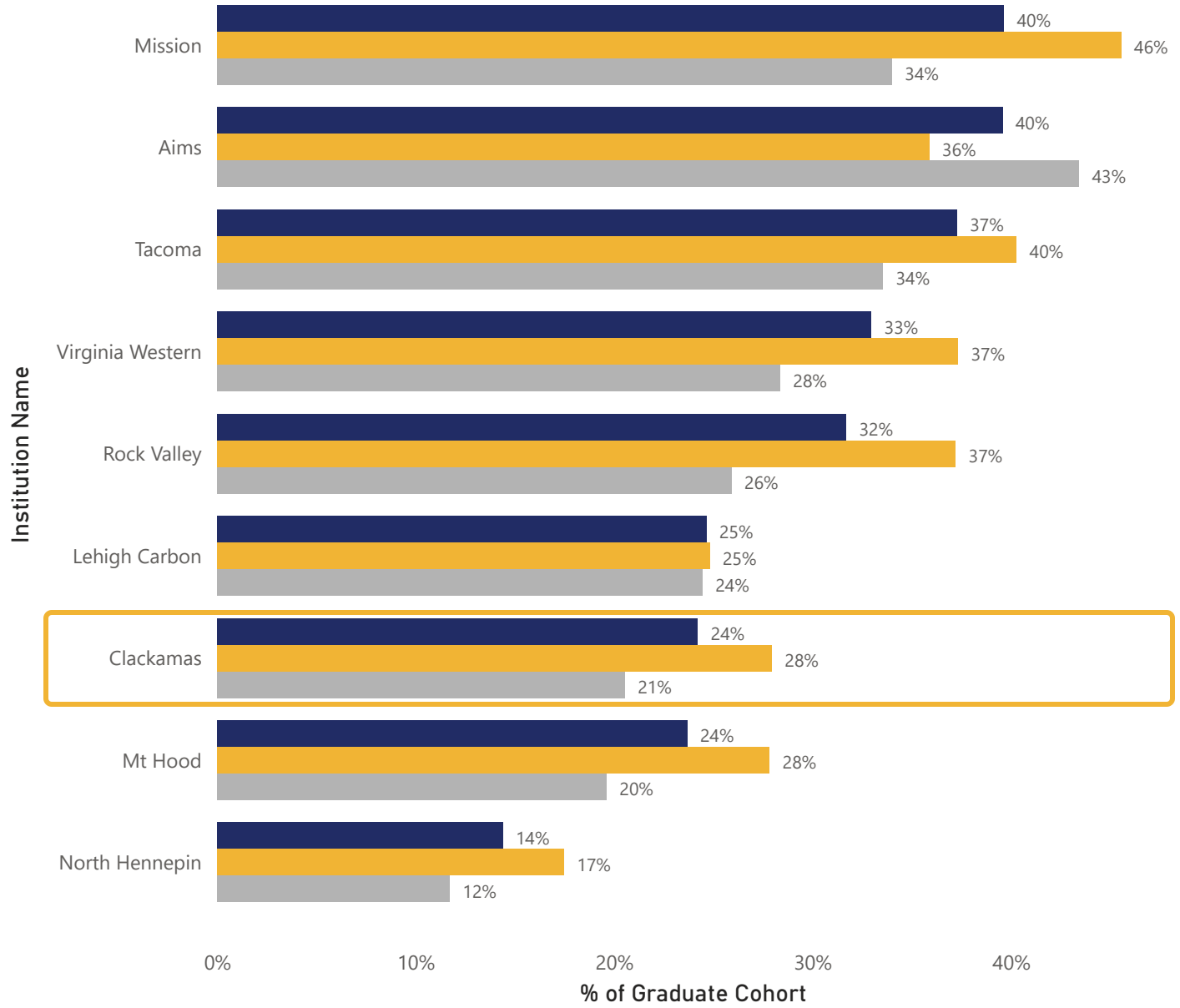
