**Cooperation Agreement Between
International Educational Services (DBA Eurocentres San Diego) (IES)
And
Clackamas Community College**

This letter shall set forth the terms and conditions under which International Educational Services (DBA Eurocentres San Diego) (IES) and Clackamas Community College (CCC) agree to cooperate in the recruitment of qualified international students to CCC's education programs. IES and CCC agree to as follows:

1. **Referral of students to CCC.** CCC agrees to participate as IES's partner institution. In connection with such, IES will recommend academically qualified international students to the CCC and encourage such students to apply to CCC. In connection with such:
 - a. IES agrees to promote CCC as one of its partner schools with the intention of increasing the student body of both schools.
 - b. Interested students will apply to both IES and CCC for admission.
 - c. IES agrees to require the following documents of prospective students, which shall subsequently be provided to CCC for consideration prior to admission:
 - i. International Student Application Form
 - ii. Copy of passport
 - iii. Official high school transcript with English translation
 - iv. Certificate of graduation from high school with English translation
 - v. Official transcripts from all colleges and universities attended with English translation.
 - vi. Certificate of financial responsibility
 - d. Upon execution of this agreement, CCC shall provide IES with information necessary to enable and make appropriate recommendations to its students applying for admission to CCC.
 - e. Any student who applies to CCC for admission to undergraduate programs shall be admitted per the criteria listed on the International Student Application (available on the website www.clackamas.edu/international).
 - f. CCC will recognize completion of Level 6 (B2/Upper Intermediate) coursework from IES as proof of English language proficiency. Students who complete Level 6 at IES may apply for admission to CCC without submitting English proficiency exam results. All other students shall be accepted upon attainment of the requisite TOEFL/IELTS score, as outlined on the CCC International Student Application.
 - g. CCC agrees to process and review applications from IES students with proof of enrollment in Level 6. If students meet all of the admission requirements, a conditional admission decision will be made pending confirmation from IES that a student has completed Level 6.
 - h. IES will transfer the student's I-20 only upon full acceptance into CCC.



2. **Inclusions:** This MOU is also inclusive of Eurocentres Vancouver and Eurocentres Toronto, both of which operate under the same management, and with the same materials, standards and assessments as IES/Eurocentres San Diego.
3. **Effective Date.** This agreement shall become effective upon signature by both parties, and shall remain effective for five years (03/04/2021) or unless either party gives prior written notification of termination.
4. **Termination Notice.** Either party may terminate this agreement at any time upon giving thirty (30) days written notice of termination to the other party.
5. **Miscellaneous.**
 - a. The activities of this MOU must be carried out in accordance with appropriate laws and regulations existing in each country and institution.
 - b. Each institution will adhere to the intellectual property laws of its respective nation. Intellectual property developed during the visit of a faculty or student visitor will be governed by the rules of the host institution unless otherwise specified by an alternate agreement. Whenever one institution receives any information from the partner under a clearly defined non-disclosure agreement, necessary steps will be taken to protect the intellectual property received.
 - c. Neither IES nor CCC shall use any trademarks, service marks, trade names, insignia, symbols, logos, decorative designs or the like which is owned by, or licensed or sublicensed to, the other party without the other party's prior written consent in each instance.
 - d. To the maximum extent permitted by law, in no event will either party be responsible for any incidental, consequential, indirect, special, punitive, or exemplary damages of any kind as a result of a breach of any warranty or any other term of this Agreement, and regardless of whether a party was advised or had reason to know of the possibility of such damages in advance.
