ACC vs. AP

Advanced College Credit (ACC) is a partnership between Clackamas Community College (CCC) and area high schools to award college credit for classes taken at the high school, taught by approved high school instructors.

Advanced Placement (AP) is governed by the College Board and allows students to earn college credit based on a standardized test that is scored on a five-point scale.

QUESTION	ACC	AP
How are credits earned?	Register and pass classes	Score 3 or higher on the test
How will it look on my transcript?	Letter grade and course #	No grade and no course #
What's the cost?	\$10 per credit*	\$98 per test
