DENTAL ASSISTANT

Dental assistants use their skills to deliver quality oral care to diverse patient populations and to increase efficiency in the office. They work closely with the dentist, hygienist and administrative staff.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN

Emergency medical technicians (EMTs) provide immediate care to critically ill or injured people on-scene and provide transportation to hospitals, care facilities and residences.

- Job locations: Ambulances and hospitals

MEDICAL BILLING AND CODING

Medical Billers and Coders work alongside physicians and medical offices to ensure accurate medical coding and billing, while also assisting patients in navigating their medical claims and bills.

- Job locations: Medical offices and hospitals

MEDICAL ASSISTANT

Medical assistants collaborate with doctors, nurses, physician assistants, behavioral health specialists and other professionals to deliver seamless, patient-centered care.

- Job locations: Ambulatory care (clinics)

Phlebotomists are trained to collect blood samples from patients and prepare the samples for testing.

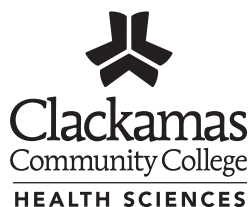
