

Aggressive Job Posting Demand Over a Thin Supply of Regional Jobs




Jobs (2021)

















Racial Diversity



Occupation Age Breakdown



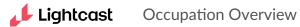


Occupation Race/Ethnicity Breakdown



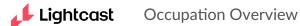
