Health Science Program(s) at Clackamas Community College requiring a clinical experience (e.g., practicum, externship, internship, etc.) must comply with Oregon Health Authority rules and requirements: <u>Nursing;</u> <u>Nursing Assistant;</u> <u>Medical Assistant;</u> <u>Dental Assistant;</u> <u>Emergency Medical Technology</u>

Oregon Health Authority (OAR 409-030-0100 to 409-030-025)

In order to obtain a clinical practicum or clinical experience, students must meet the following standards and requirements set forth by the State. If you have been convicted of a misdemeanor or felony, please contact the program director for additional information. Deadlines and due dates for completing OHA requirements may vary by program.

Criminal Background Check

□ Criminal background check must be completed prior to clinical placement and no more than three months before entering the program

Drug Screen

□ Drug Screen must be completed prior to clinical placement and no more than three months before entering the program

TB Skin Test (2 Step) or Chest X-Ray There must be documentation of one of the following:

- □ 2 step TB skin test or (non-nursing programs only)
- Quantiferon Gold blood test or
- □ T-Spot blood test or
- □ If the results are positive a clear Chest X-Ray (with lab report) is required

Tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis (Tdap) There must be documentation the following:

□ Tdap/Td booster within the past 10 years

Varicella (Chicken Pox) There must be documentation of <u>one</u> of the following:

- □ 2 vaccinations or
- Positive antibody titer (lab report required) or
- □ Medically documented history of disease

Measles, Mumps & Rubella (MMR) There must be documentation of one of the following:

- □ 2 vaccinations or
- Desitive antibody titers for all 3 components (lab reports required)

Hepatitis B There must be documentation of <u>one</u> of the following:

- 3 vaccinations or
- Positive antibody titer (lab report required)

COVID-19 (OAR 333-019-010)

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- 2 vaccinations Pfizer or
- 2 vaccinations Moderna or
- □ 1 vaccinations Johnson & Johnson

Flu Vaccine (Recommended by OHA and required by some employers)

Seasonal flu vaccine

BLS/CPR Certification (Must be valid through the end date of the course)

Certification must be through the American Heart Association
