Drug \$	Screen  □ Drug Screen must be completed prior to clinical placement and no more than three months before entering the program
TB Blo	Dod Test or Chest X-Ray There must be documentation of one of the following:  ☐ Quantiferon Gold blood test or ☐ T-Spot blood test or ☐ If the results are positive a clear Chest X-Ray (with lab report) is required
Tetanı	us, diphtheria, pertussis (Tdap) There must be documentation the following:  Tdap/Td booster within the past 10 years
Varice	ella (Chicken Pox) There must be documentation of one of the following:  2 vaccinations or  Positive antibody titer (lab report required) or  Medically documented history of disease
Measl	es, Mumps & Rubella (MMR) There must be documentation of <u>one</u> of the following:  2 vaccinations or  Positive antibody titers for all 3 components (lab reports required)
Hepat	itis B There must be documentation of <u>one</u> of the following:  ☐ 3 vaccinations or ☐ Positive antibody titer (lab report required)
COVIE	D-19 (Recommended by OHA and required by some employers)  Full series and/or booster
Flu Va	Ccine (Recommended by OHA and required by some employers)  Seasonal flu vaccine

BLS/CPR Certification (Must be valid through the end date of the course)
