

# Math and Writing Placement Overview

## Where to find your math and placement results

1. Go to [my.clackamas.edu](http://my.clackamas.edu).
2. Log-in using your CCC user log-in name and password.

3. On the left hand side, select "Self Service" and then "Self Service: Student."

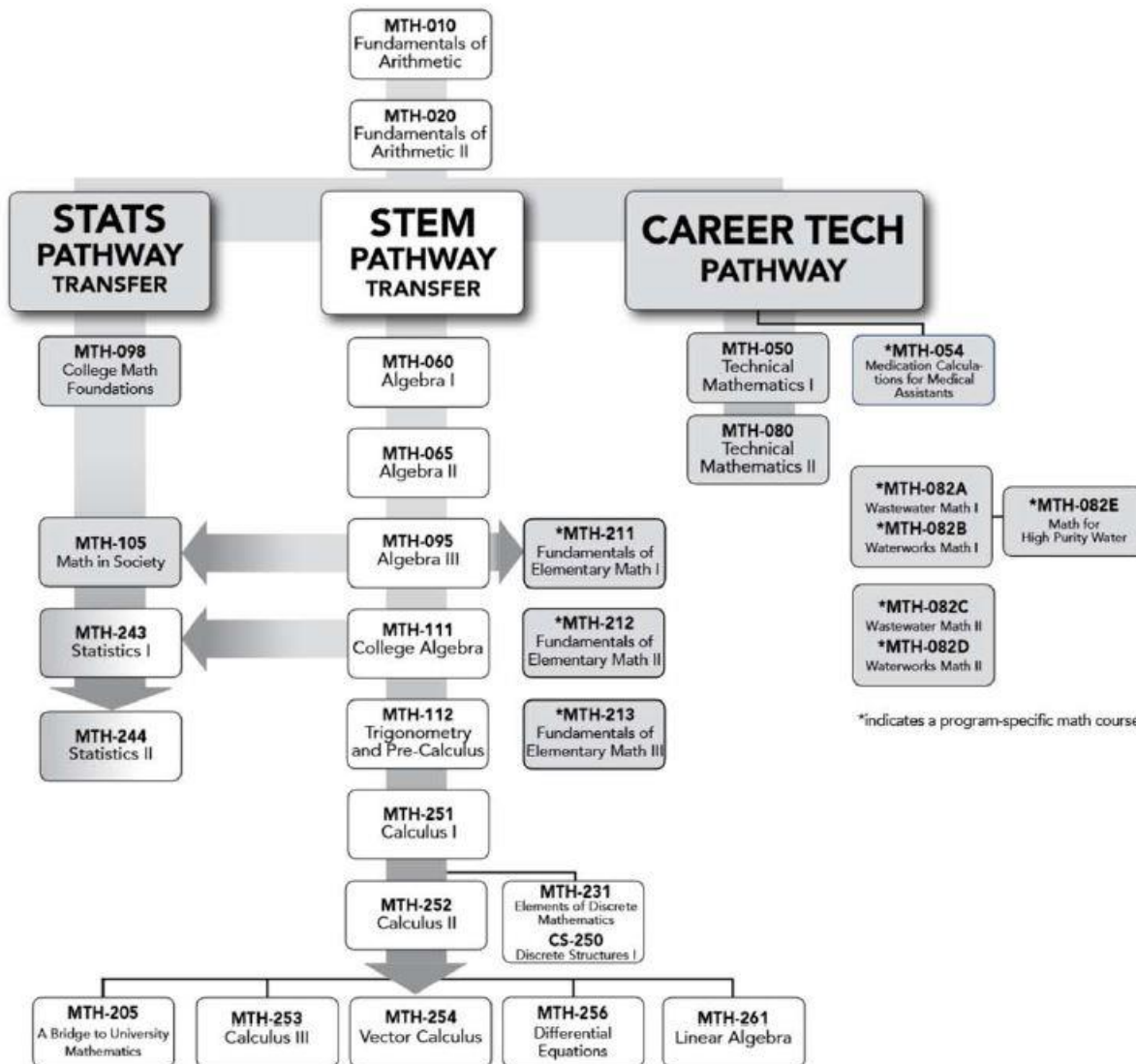
